**RE: Property additions for Churubusco area proposed sanitary sewer projects**

The recently formed Whitley County Regional Water and Sewer District (Whitley RSD) has been meeting with property owners in your area to discuss a proposed sanitary sewer extension into the area. This proposed project is in response to several Department of Health citations as well as hosted a public meeting at the Faith Lutheran Church on July 10, 2018. The purpose of the meeting was to bring residents who were recently added to the proposed sanitary sewer project up to date on the status of the project. Estimated costs of extending sanitary sewer systems into the Churubusco area, as an alternative to individual onsite sewage system (septic) upgrades and individual homeowner responsibilities at the time of installation were also presented.

We did not find your name on the sign-in sheet from the meeting. Please find, included in this mailing a copy of the packet that was handed out at the meeting, which explains the initial cost estimate for the proposed municipal sewer project. The information packet also includes a survey sheet to gauge your interest in the project based on the costs presented.

The survey is a yes or no vote that gauges your interest in connecting to the sanitary sewer project. If the sanitary sewer is not extended into your area then existing public health issues such as illegally discharging septic systems will be identified by Department of Health and may require individual onsite upgrades or other actions to correct the issues.

**Your input on this proposed municipal sewer project is important. Please complete the survey and return it to the Whitley RSD in the enclosed business reply envelope by August 13, 2018.** The survey responses that we receive will guide the Whitley RSD Board of Trustees decision on whether or not to move forward with this proposed municipal sewer project.
