SUBJECT: Whitley RSD Board eliminates Stable Acres from current project list

You are receiving this letter as a property owner in the Laud community and area. This letter is to update you in regards to the regularly scheduled Whitley RSD Board meeting that was held on Tuesday, February 22nd, 2019. Before selecting engineering design firms for the 2018_01 package of sanitary sewer projects the Board of Trustees voted to remove the Stable Acres project from the list with a 3/2 vote in favor of this decision. The project area will now be handed over to the Whitley County Health Department for decisions moving forward.

The elimination of the Stable Acres project makes the Laud project completely infeasible at this time. The Board will continue to look into grant funding for this project in the future however, at this time no further action will take place. This area may be revisited by the Whitley RSD at a later date as the environmental concerns remain. The project may also be revisited at the request of residents by means of an amended petition.
